Phase 0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All schools closed to public access ● Food Service is 100% remote ● Transportation is not provided 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The primary delivery of instruction will be remote with no possibility of in-person instruction or support ● Select curricular areas (e.g., Ag-Ed, Student Built Home) that are dependent on student involvement will not provide onsite instruction and support ● Current attendance incentive policies are suspended ● No extra-curricular activities ● No field trips ● No student or staff school-related travel ● All school facilities closed to public rental
Phase I Limited student access depending on curriculum area and student need	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student groups kept together ● Food Service is 100% remote ● Transportation is provided on a limited basis ● Required health screening completed by parent before the child(ren) leave the home each morning ● Health screening and hand sanitizing upon entry required ● Handwashing and germ transmission prevention pro-actively taught and frequently encouraged ● Frequent sanitizing of physical space and equipment ● Per the Governor's Order: Face coverings are required at all times when present in a district building or riding district transportation. Exceptions are outlined in the Pandemic Operational Guidance. ● Public visitors to schools limited to only essential school business (deliveries, contractors) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The primary delivery of instruction will be remote with the possibility and on a very limited and targeted basis, the ability for our building administrators to work collaboratively with staff to determine if a student should be invited for a 1:1 check for academic and/or social/emotional support ● Select curricular areas (e.g., Ag-Ed, Student Built Home) that are dependent on student involvement will be on a case-by-case basis for onsite instruction and support ● Current attendance incentive policies are suspended ● Accommodations will be extended to students and staff who are required to quarantine due to exposure or potential exposure ● No extra-curricular activities ● No field trips ● No student or staff school related travel ● All school facilities closed to public rental ● The district may adopt an alternative schedule to accommodate smaller groups in the case of extended closure

<p style="text-align: center;">Phase II</p> <p>Group size not to exceed 50</p> <p>Static grouping not required</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student groups allowed to mix, with gatherings not to exceed 50 students ● Food Service is 100% on site ● Transportation is provided ● Required health screening completed by parent before the child(ren) leave the home each morning ● Hand sanitizing upon entry ● Handwashing and germ transmission prevention pro-actively taught and frequently encouraged ● Frequent sanitizing of physical space and equipment ● Face coverings are required at all times when present in a district building or riding district transportation. Exceptions are outlined in the Pandemic Operational Guidance. ● Public visitors to schools limited to school related business and will be required to wear face coverings (guest speakers, trainers, curriculum related activities) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The primary delivery of instruction will be on site with traditional schedules ● Families may choose remote learning ● Current attendance incentive policies are suspended ● Accommodations will be extended to students and staff who are required to quarantine due to exposure or potential exposure ● Extra-curricular activities resume in compliance with district activities limitations on crowd/group size, activity type, health protocols, and MHSAs regulations ● Field trips permitted on a case-by-case basis ● Student or staff school related travel permitted on a case-by-case basis ● Mass gatherings (e.g., dances, assemblies, concerts) allowed if social distancing protocols can be adhered to ● School facility rental permitted on a case-by-case basis with a plan approved by the county health department
<p style="text-align: center;">Phase III</p> <p>Group size can exceed 50</p> <p>Static grouping not required</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student schedules and routines are normal ● Food Service is 100% on site with typical routines ● Transportation is provided ● Recommended health screening completed by parent before the child(ren) leave the home each morning ● Recommended hand sanitizing upon entry ● Handwashing and germ transmission prevention pro-actively taught and frequently encouraged ● Frequent sanitizing of physical space and equipment ● Face coverings at the discretion of the individual. Per current CDC guidelines: face coverings recommended for those not vaccinated ● Public visitors to schools limited to school related business (guest speakers, trainers, curriculum related activities, and volunteers) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The primary delivery of instruction will be on site with traditional schedules ● Current attendance incentive policies will be reviewed by administration with recommendations being developed ● Accommodations will be extended to students and staff who are required to quarantine due to exposure or potential exposure; extended leave benefits will not be available ● Extra-curricular activities resume per MHSAs regulations ● Field trips allowed ● Student or staff school related travel allowed ● Mass gatherings allowed ● School facilities will be open to public rental
