How Can I "GO GLOBAL"?

The International Language Academy distinction acknowledges graduating seniors that complete a plan emphasizing an international language focus in one of the two languages, Spanish or French. *To be eligible for this distinction, the student must complete all requirements as outlined below.* Students earning this distinction are eligible to wear a **light blue** distinction cord at graduation.

International Language Academy Criteria for Distinction

- Complete four consecutive years in one of the two languages: Spanish or French
- Complete TWO years of another language offered at GHS OR complete a 15 item portfolio from the extra curricular/community service list of options on/before March 1 of senior year
- Cumulative overall GPA of 3.2 and 3.2 in all IL courses
