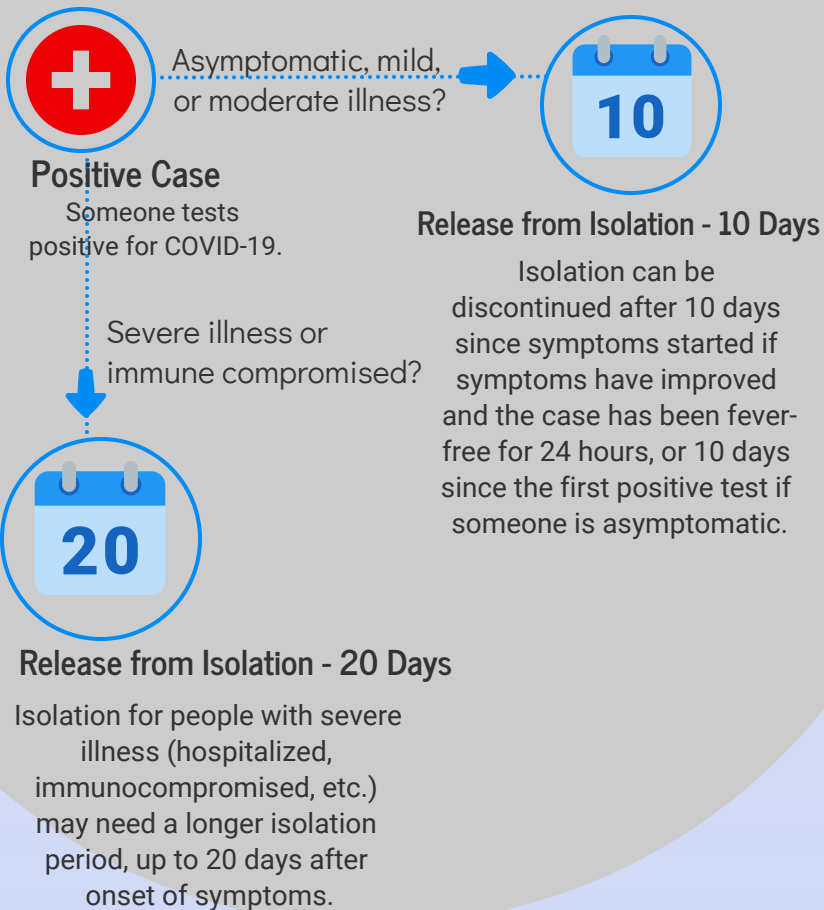
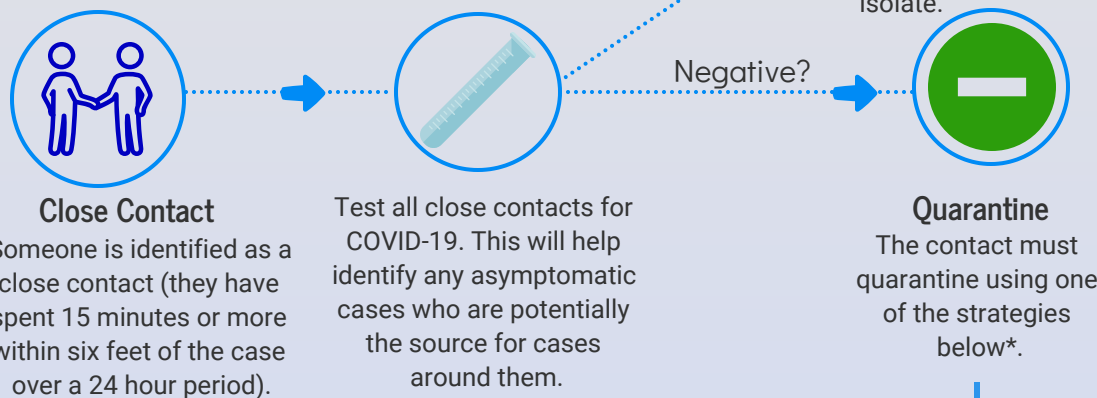


Isolation and Quarantine Guidance for COVID-19

Isolation of Cases



Quarantine of Contacts



*Local public health makes the final decision about how long quarantine should last.

14

Preferred Method: 14 Day Quarantine

The contact may be released from quarantine on day 14, if no signs and symptoms are present. This option must be applied for all residents and staff of long term care facilities.

10

10 Day Quarantine

The contact may be released from quarantine on day 10 without testing, as long as the contact has no signs and symptoms.

7

7 Day Quarantine

The contact may be released from quarantine on day 7 after receiving a negative test result (the test must be collected on day 5 or later).

- After stopping quarantine, contacts should continue to watch for symptoms for 14 days after exposure.
- If a contact becomes symptomatic during quarantine, they should contact their healthcare provider to discuss testing options.
